Catherine Carmody, age 93, of Nevada, Iowa formerly of Melrose died Wednesday, May 30, 2007 at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames, Iowa. She was born on June 15, 1913 to James and Catherine Philomena (Coady) O'Brien. She married Matthew Francis Carmody on August 20, 1945 at the St. Patricks Catholic Church in Melrose. He died March 31, 1981.

Catherine attended the St. Josephs Academy in Ottumwa, Iowa. She had worked in the Ammunition Plant in Ankeny, Iowa and was a homemaker. She was a member of the St. Patricks Catholic Church in Melrose and it's Altar & Rosary Society and the St. Patricks Catholic Church and St. Ann's Club of Nevada, Iowa.
