Charles Edward Jones, age 93 of Albia died Friday evening August 28, 2009 at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Charlie was born in Melrose, Iowa on May 19, 1916, to William and Kathryn (Ryan) Jones. Charlie was raised in Melrose. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII.

Charlie worked at various jobs throughout his life. He retired from John Deere in Ottumwa. Charlie was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, a 3rd and 4th degree Knight of Columbus, and a member of the American Legion, Howard Cessna Post #136.

Charlie married Betty Jane McGinn on January 22, 1946 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Weller. They were married for 63 years and blessed with four children.
