Clarence Wayne Van Egdome, age 83 of Albia, passed away peacefully Tuesday, July 16, 2013, after a battle with liver cancer.

Clarence was born November 21, 1929, to Antonie and Alice (Roovaart) Van Egdome near Montezuma, IA. He graduated from Montezuma High School in 1947, and worked on the family farm with his siblings, Elmer, Larry, and Marlene (Ingle).

Clarence moved to Albia in 1966 and worked various jobs; retiring from the Albia Grain Elevator in 1994. He served the Lord as elder at Chariton Church of Christ for 37 years, and was well known for his small engine repair service until his illness. He also really enjoyed working on radios and televisions.
