



## Clyde Dickerson

November 14, 1943 - March 18, 2015

Clyde Dickerson, age 71, of Albia, passed away March 18, 2015 at his home in Albia.

He was born November 14, 1943 to Floyd and Mary Ann (Houser) in Lawton, Oklahoma. Clyde lived in Missouri for a while before moving to Iowa at the age of 12. He attended high school in Oskaloosa, Iowa. While still attending high school, Clyde joined the United States Army in 1962 and served his country until 1965. On February 21, 1975 he married Mary Ann Tomlinson at the First Christian Church in Albia, and to this union 2 children were born, Linda and Clyde (Ed).

Clyde was a farm hand for most of his early life before going to work at the Veterans Hospital in Iowa City.
