Cynthia “Cyndi” Jo Price, age 60, of Albia, passed away on Wednesday, January 16, 2019, at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Cyndi was born on November 30, 1958, in Aurora, IL, to Jerry and Shirley (Repp) Anderson. They moved to Albia, IA, when Cyndi was in middle school. She graduated from the Albia High School with the class of 1977 before attending Indian Hills Community College and later William Penn College in Oskaloosa where she majored in Accounting and minored in Economics.
