Daniel F. Lenger, age 76, passed away Tuesday, January 18, 2011 at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Daniel was born February 25, 1934 to Albert and Kathryn (Flahive) Lenger in Monroe County. He grew up and attended Hamilton school.
