Daryl Jay Clipperton, age 64, of Hamilton, died Wednesday, August 26, 2009, at the Hospice Comfort House in Pella, Iowa.

Daryl was born on March 13, 1945, in Knoxville, Iowa to Noble Ernest and Irene (Godfrey) Clipperton. He attended and graduated from Twin Cedars High School Class of 1963. After high school Daryl worked construction before he was drafted and served in the U.S. Army. He was stationed at Fort Carson, CO. until 1967. After serving his country Daryl married Beverly Jo Rankin on Flag Day, June 14, 1968 at the Methodist Church in Attica.
