David Leo Heffron, age 79 of Melrose, passed away Monday, April 21, 2014, at his home.

David was born November 2, 1934, to Michael Joseph and Agnes Margaret (Murphy) Heffron in Georgetown. He married Kathleen Ryan on August 20, 1966, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Weller, IA. They were blessed with six children, Paul, Steve, Christine, Don, Jim, and Maureen.

David graduated from Georgetown High School in 1952 and went on to serve his country in the U.S. Army stationed in Germany. He played softball for the Georgetown Shamrocks and baseball in Albia in his younger years. He worked at Baxter Box Factory in Centerville, and also Chamberlain's and Coady Plumbing and Heating for many years. Then David farmed south of Melrose for the rest of his life.

David was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Melrose and Knights of Columbus St. Mary's Council 4167. He was a devout Catholic and studied the Catholic religion, along with attending First Friday Masses and Adoration. He was a weather spotter when he was younger. He enjoyed being outdoors, farming and hunting throughout his life. He was very proud of the family farm being a Century Farm, and loved spending time with his grandchildren and watching their activities.
