David John "Red" Jamieson, age 81, passed away Friday, February 11, 2011 at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Red was born July 4, 1929 to Thomas Bell and Annie Mae (Evans) Jamieson in Hiteman, Iowa. Red attended school in Albia. He married Lois June Lundstrom on June 26, 1948 in Albia. Lois died April 14, 2008.

He worked for Chicago, Burlington and Quincy (CB and Q) for five years and built roads for Strolther and Reims before serving in the United States Army from 1952 to 1955. He was stationed at Ft. Leonard Wood in Missouri, Walters Air Force Base in Mineral Wells, Texas, and served one year overseas in the West Indies in Luther Island in the Bahamas. He worked for Cunningham and Reese from 1955 until he retired at the age of 65 in 1994.

Red was a lifetime member and past commander of the American Legion and the V.F.W. He was also a courtesy member of the Knights of Columbus.

Red is survived by his children Mary (David) Corbett of Montezuma, David (Judy) Jamieson of Albia, Robert (Cynthia) Jamieson of Indianola, John Mark (Lorrie) Jamieson of Corydon; thirteen grandchildren; eleven great grandchildren; and three great -great grandchildren; two sisters Kathryn Conway of Melrose, Dorothy Spurgin of Albia, and a brother, Thomas "Stub" Jamieson of Albia.

Red was preceded in death by his wife Lois; one grandson Cory Vansant; and two brothers Raymond and Marvin "Buzz" Jamieson.

A memorial has been established to the Welcome Home Soldier Memorial.
