



Dennis Lloyd Comstock

November 1, 1948 - July 5, 2013

Dennis "Denny" Lloyd Comstock, age 64 of Albia, passed away after a long battle with cancer Friday, July 5, 2013, under the care of Monroe County Hospice at Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Denny was born November 1, 1948, to Robert Michael and Lorraine Josephine (Tice) Comstock in his grandmother's home in Albia. He married Cinda Stocker in 1995 at their home.

A graduate of Albia High School, class of 1966, Denny enlisted in the United States Army April 26, 1970. After being honorably discharged April 26, 1976, he began working at Younkers as a stock clerk. He later worked for a meat packing plant in Illinois, Vermeer, John Deere, Grady Enterprises, and retired from 3M.

Denny was a member of the American Legion, Howard Cessna Post #136. He loved wildlife, especially eagles and deer, being outdoors, putting up hay, and going on vacations. Anyone who knew him knew he was very artistic and didn't know a stranger. Family was everything to Denny, and he loved spending time with them.
