Diane Faye Schell, age 64, passed away Sunday, March 13, 2011 at her home in Albia.

Diane was born March 8, 1947 to Albanus and Helen (Schoener) Miller in Chester, Pennsylvania. Diane graduated from high school and received her teaching degree in Pennsylvania.
