Dora "Jean" Bradley, age 88 of Albia, died Saturday, April 7, 2012 under the care of Hospice of Monroe County, at her home in Albia.

Jean was born August 13, 1923 in Newtown, MO to Thomas and Dora (Demry) Starns. She married Bob Bradley on November 17, 1962 at the First Christian Church in Unionville. They shared 45 years of marriage before Bob's passing on December 30, 2007.

In 1962 Jean and Bob moved to Albia, where they owned and operated Bradley Produce until 1978. Jean was a volunteer at the First Christian Church, and was past president of the Christian Church CWF Auxiliary, as well as a Deacon.
