Edith Jane Anderson, age 81, of Des Moines formerly of Albia, died Saturday, September 12, 2009, at the Mercy Hospice in Johnston, Iowa.

Edith was born June 16, 1928, in Omaha, Nebraska to Harry Earl and Mabel (Christenson) Thomas. She attended and graduated from Albia High School class of 1946. Edith married Bobby "Bob" Anderson on September 21, 1947 at the St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Albia. Edith and Bob were married for 61 years and blessed with two children. Bob died on November 13, 2008.

Edith was a homemaker and assisted her husband Bob operating Best Oil and Gas Company. They were in the petroleum marketing business for 41 years, retiring in 1987.

Edith was active all her life. She was the last living charter member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church. She was the first woman to serve on St. Paul's Church Council, she was the co-chairperson for St. Paul's building committee, and she also held many other positions with St. Paul's women's church groups during her life. She was also a former member of the Monroe County Hospital Auxiliary. Edith and Bob also traveled around the world with Friendship Forces.

Edith is survived by two children, David and wife Mary Anderson of Oskaloosa, Jean and her husband Brent Lozano of Ankeny; and 4 grandchildren, Nicholas, Matthew, and Steven Anderson, and Paige Lozano. Edith is preceded in death by her parents; her husband Bob; one brother, Howard Thomas; and two sisters, Loraine Dodds, and Marie Louise Thomas in infancy.
