



## Edward W. Johnston

April 30, 1922 - December 6, 2008

Edward "Pete" W. Johnston, age 86, a resident of Oakwood Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Albia, Iowa, died Saturday, December 6, 2008, at the care center in Albia.

Edward was born April 30, 1922 in Van Buren County to Lloyd and Eva (Thompson) Johnston. On April 25, 1943, he married Dorothy J. Cash in Ottumwa, Iowa.

Pete attended school in Van Buren and Wapello Counties and graduated from Ottumwa High School in 1940. He worked at Morrells, farmed and went into electronic work. Pete entered the Navy on November 15, 1942 and served at the Ottumwa Navy Base and Barbers Point, Hawaii, during WWII. He was discharged November 30, 1945, as a 2nd Class Aviation Machinist Mate.
