Elizabeth (Bea) Juliette Stone Lahart, age 95 of Albia was called home Thursday, July 9, 2015. Elizabeth was born December 3rd 1919 to George Sr, and Johanna (Feehan) Stone. in rural Monroe County. She married Edward Judge Lahart on November 23rd, 1948.
