Frances Elizabeth Spears, age 93, of Albia, passed away August 29, 2015 at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Frances was born November 14, 1921 to Harry and Carrie (Newman) Tisue in Moravia. She graduated from Moravia High School, Class of 1939. On May 31, 1942 Frances married Daniel Spears in Unionville, Missouri. They shared 48 years of marriage together before Dan's passing on September 13, 1990.
