Dr. Gary Wayne Davis, age 60, of Albia passed away Saturday February 5, 2011 at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Gary was born September 8, 1950 to Ottis Azel and Mildred Darlene (Sinclair) Davis in Blakesburg. Gary was a graduate of Albia High School and also from Northeast Missouri State University. In 1978 Gary graduated from Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine. He completed his internship at Davenport Osteopathic Hospital, completing in 1979.

On August 20, 1970 Gary and Linda Wagner were married in Blakesburg. They were blessed with four children and later divorced.

In 1980 Gary opened his practice in Albia and Ottumwa. He operated his practice for over 10 years in Albia and Ottumwa. He currently worked for Acute Care Inc., as an Emergency Room Physician, serving Iowa and Minnesota.

Gary enjoyed learning, history, and life. He was a private aircraft owner and pilot. He was a member of several associations, including the Blakesburg Air Association. He liked hunting, motorcycles, and especially his dog Meka.

Gary is survived by Betty Landgrebe of Albia; his children Katie (Steve) Seifert of Moline, Ill, Greg (Jenisha) Davis of Albia, Brad Davis and Sarah Kouri of Des Moines, and Scott (Ashlee) Davis of Omaha, NE; Betty's children Jill Wright of Portland, OR, Rick Landgrebe of Oskaloosa, and Donita (Damon) Smith of Pella.
