Glen Davis, age 68 of Albia, passed away Friday, July 4, 2014, at Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Glen was born March 3, 1946, to Handy Clifford and Elsie Blanche (King) Davis. He attended Buffalo Wallow Country School and later attended Albia High School, graduating in the class of 1964. After high school, Glen served his country in the United States Army during Vietnam. After returning from Vietnam, he married Lois Dianne Barnes on September 2, 1971, at the Methodist Church in Albia. To this union, 2 sons, Steve and Scott were born.

After returning from Vietnam, Glen worked at Chamberlains in Albia for 19  $\frac{3}{4}$  years. He worked at Hormel in Ottumwa for 12 years and then at Pella Corp. for 18 years. Glen especially enjoyed spending time with his family.
