Harry Arthur Waldron, Sr., age 66 of Melrose, died under the care of Hospice of Central Iowa at his home in Melrose.

Harry was born June 23, 1947 to John Arthur and Audrey Mae (Brown) Waldron in Mansfield, OH. He married Esther Richmond at her home in Albia in 1980. They later divorced.

After graduating high school, Harry began work on a farm before joining the United States Army and serving two tours in Vietnam. Following the war, he worked for Burlington Northern Railroad and then the Soo Line Railroad.

Harry was a past member of the American Legion. He loved being outdoors, fishing, hunting, mushroom hunting, raising ducks and chickens, and watching humming birds. He liked joking with people along with going to garage sales and thrift stores. He also loved spending time with family and friends, especially his grandchildren.

Harry is survived by three children, Jennifer (fiancé, Brad Howard) Jass of Oskaloosa, Harry "Buddy" (Natalie Baker) Waldron, Jr. of Albia; and Kevin (Shannon) Waldron of Albia; four grandchildren, Treyton Waldron, Xander Jass, Skylar Waldron (his mother, Rachael Stout), and Jackson Baker; his father, John Waldron; two step children, Linda (Dan) Scholtus and Sandy

Brown; four siblings, Bill Waldron, Angie Lewis, James Waldron, and John Waldron; and several step grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

Harry was preceded in death by his mother; a sister, Esther; three grandchildren, Nathan, Zachary, and Alexis Jass; and two step children, Wayne and Jim.
