Imogene Grace Barnhart, age 81 of Greentop, MO, formerly of Albia, passed away Tuesday, July 17, 2012, at the Good Samaritan Society in Ottumwa.

Imogene was born January 10, 1931, at home in Albia, to William and Irene (Dunsmoor) McCarty. She married Dean Graham on December 11, 1948, in Albia, and to this union they had nine children. Dean passed away after 37 years of marriage, in 1985. Imogene married Robert "Bob" Barnhart on March 10, 1990, in Las Vegas.

A graduate of Albia High School, Class of 1948, Imogene began working at the Albia Hospital in the office as a bookkeeper. She was the executive secretary at Peoples National Bank in Albia until 1986, when she went to work for First National Bank of Kirksville, which later was renamed, Midwest Bank of Kirksville. She also was the Senior Regent at the Moose Lodge and bookkeeper for the city of Greentop, along with working for FDIC between Albia and Kirksville.

Imogene was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and Moose Lodge in Kirksville. She enjoyed gardening, ceramics, traveling, and being around people. She was one of the first softball league coaches in Albia, and loved spending time with family and friends, especially her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.
