Irene Elizabeth Crall age 93, of Albia, died Wednesday, March 11, 2010, at Monroe Care Center in Albia.

Irene was born July 11, 1916 in Weller, to John and Anna (Nigut) Popson. She grew up and attended school at rural Bucknell School. She married John E. "Jack" Crall on September 28, 1940, at St Mary's Catholic Church in Weller. They were blessed with 19 years of marriage and four children, before John died on January 29, 1960.

Irene was a homemaker, and worked in the 1960's to the 1980's at the Weller Store in Weller. Later she was a carpenter's assistant, and helped at the Russell Sale Barn. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Albia, Altar and Rosary Society, and the Golden Age Circle. Irene loved gardening and flowers.
