



James "Jim" Edward Carmody

James "Uncle Jim" Edward Carmody, age 88 of Melrose, died Thursday, August 30, 2012 at Mercy Medical Center in Centerville.

Jim was born October 22, 1923 to John Joseph and Ella Josephine (Walsh) Carmody in Melrose, Iowa. Jim attended and graduated from Melrose High School, Class of 1941.

He served his country in the United States Army during World War II. After returning home from the Army Jim farmed on the family farm with his brothers in Melrose. Jim was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Melrose.

Burial will follow services at Mt. Calvary Cemetery in Melrose, with military rites provided by the American Legion, of Melrose, Albia and Lovilia.

Visitation will be held from 2:00 P.M. until 8 P.M., Monday, September 3, 2012 at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Melrose. A rosary will be led Monday at 4 PM, provided by St. Patrick's Altar and Rosary Society, and a Christian Wake Service will be held at 7:00 P.M. with Jim's family present from 4 to 8 P.M.
