James "Jim" Walter Lenger, age 76 of Bussey, IA, passed away Sunday, April 4, 2021 at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines.

Jim was born December 23, 1944, to Albert and Kathryn (Flahive) Lenger on the farm at home east of Hamilton. He grew up and attended school in Hamilton and later in Lovilia. On October 11, 1969, Jim was united in marriage to Nancy Chance at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Weller, IA. To this union, 2 children, Jeff and Kevin were born. Jim and Nancy shared 51 years of marriage prior to his passing.

After school, Jim worked at Maytag in Newton for 30 years in various positions. He also farmed throughout his adult life. Jim was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Lovilia and the Knights of Columbus in Albia. He enjoyed being outdoors, being on the farm, riding around in his gator and loved his German Shepherd, Blade. He was an avid Iowa Hawkeyes football and basketball fan.
