



## JoAnn Marie (Sager) Post

JoAnn Marie (Sager) Post, age 86, of Albia, IA, passed away on Tuesday, September 10, 2024, at Crystal Heights Care Center in Oskaloosa, IA.

JoAnn was born on February 1, 1938, in Council Bluffs, NE, to Irvin and Eleanor (Scott) Sager. She graduated from Lovilia High School in 1956. 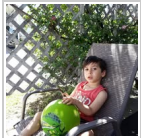
