John Arthur Clouse, age 79, of Albia, passed away on Thursday, October 24, 2019, at his home in Albia, under the care of Care Initiatives Hospice, surrounded by his loved ones.

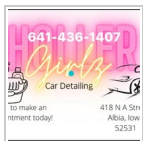
