Josephine Ann "Joann" (Flahive) Derby, age 78 of Atlantic, formerly of Albia, passed away Saturday, February 14, 2015, at Exira Care Center in Exira.

Joann was born on November 4, 1936, in Weller, Iowa to Bill and Mary Ann (Bingaman) Flahive. She attended school in Lovilia, Iowa and graduated from Lovilia High School in 1954.
