Joshua Lee Wuebker, age 29, died suddenly at his home in Lovilia on Friday March 11, 2011.

Josh was born August 20, 1981 in Ottumwa to Kevin Lee and Mari Roxane (Richmond) Wuebker. Josh was raised in Lovilia and graduated from Albia High School, class of 2000. After high school he attended and graduated from Iowa State University in 2005, receiving his degree in Agriculture Studies. Since college Josh worked in the agriculture field. He was currently employed with AgriGold Seed Company.

Joshua and Emily Harris were united in marriage on August 18, 2007 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Albia. They were blessed with two children, Graecie and Bailey. Josh and Emily later divorced.

Josh was a very active man. He was a member of the Lovilia Fire and Rescue Department, St. Peter's Catholic Church and the Iowa State Alumni Association. Joshua was a devoted Iowa State fan; he enjoyed hunting, camping, hanging out with his family and friends, and music. His two greatest loves in life were his two girls.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents Bill and Maddonna Richmond; and his infant brother Jared Newton Wuebker.

Joshua is survived by his two children Graecie Jolee Wuebker and Bailey Marie Ann Wuebker; his parents Kevin and Roxane Wuebker of Lovilia; and his sisters Alisha Maddonna Wuebker and Shelby Danielle Wuebker both of Lovilia. Josh is also survived by his special friend Pam Starcevic of Albia.
