Kathryn Ann Galloway, age 75, of Albia passed away Tuesday, January 13, 2015, at the Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Kathryn was born April 11, 1939 in Albia to Floyd Dexter and Anna Faye (Simon) Galloway. She attended Albia High School graduating with the class of 1957. After High School, Kathryn attended the Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls and graduated with the class of 1961.

She taught physical education, coached girls basketball, and cheerleading at a High School before going to teach at Auburn School for the Blind. After her teaching career she went to work at the V.A in Knoxville in the drug and alcohol unit as a rehab tech before retiring in 2001.

Kathryn was a member of NARFE (National Active and Retired Federal Employees), the Albia Sweet Adelines, the First Christian Church, the women's study group, and a member of their Prayer Tree. She was passionate in her beliefs and very giving, often baking for the church. Kathryn often volunteered to drive people to their doctor appointments. Kathryn was skilled at wood working and was good at wiring. She was independent, big hearted, and loving. Her real joy in life was her family especially her nieces and nephews.

Kathryn is survived by two sisters, Elaine Dostal, and Betty (Robert) Butler, both of Chicago, IL; and 10 nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Floyd and Anna; and two brothers, William and Darrell Galloway.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m., Saturday, January 17, 2015 at First Christian Church in Albia, with Pastor Lynda Carlson officiating. Burial will follow services in Oak View Cemetery in Albia.

Visitation will be held from 9:30 a.m. until time of services on Saturday, January 17, 2015 at the First Christian Church in Albia, with Kathryn's family present.
