Kathryne Lorraine "Kaye" Flattery, 85, of Albia, died Saturday, Aug. 20, 2011, at the Monroe County Hospital, Albia, under the care of hospice.

She was born Jan. 21, 1926, in Monroe County, daughter of Casper and Mayme Lahart Coady. She married Vincent James Flattery Aug. 12, 1946, at St Mary's Catholic Church in Albia. He preceded her in death Jan. 16, 2010.

A 1944 graduate of Georgetown High School, Kaye had been employed at Albia Dairy Bar, in the café at the Albia Sale Barn and had worked on the Monroe County Election Board.
