Kay McGee, age 88, of Albia, passed away on Wednesday, October 6, 2010, at the Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Kay was born on December 17, 1921, in Monroe County near Weller, Iowa, to John and Anna (Nigut) Papson. She graduated from Melrose High School.

Kay married William McGee Jr. on June 26, 1943, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Weller. They shared 37 years of marriage before William's death in 1980.
