Lawrence "Chief" Rupert Beaver, age 62 of Eddyville, passed away Friday, September 7, 2012, at Mahaska Health Partnership in Oskaloosa.

Lawrence was born July 30, 1950 to John and Mary (Auger) Beaver in Desmarais, Alberta, Canada. He was a member of the Bigstone Cree Indian Nation. He married Mary Lou Tracey on June 14, 1975 in Oskaloosa.

Lawrence graduated from high school in Alberta, Canada, and later moved to the United States, where he worked at Maytag for 32 years.

Lawrence was a very friendly and giving person. He always liked helping his neighbors and family. He enjoyed being outdoors, cutting wood, farming and working on cars. He was a handy-man and was Mary Lou's right-hand-man at Wilson's in Bussey. He also was an animal lover and loved spending time with his family and friends.

Lawrence is survived by his wife of 37 years, Mary Lou of Eddyville; five siblings, Claire Clark, Leonard Beaver, Rita Large, John Beaver, all of Canada, and Liz Larson of Albia. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews, cousins, and sisters and brothers-in-law.

Lawrence was preceded in death by his parents, grandparents, and a brother,
