Leo David Flattery, age 87, passed away Tuesday morning, December 21, 2010 at the Monroe Care Center in Albia.

David was born September 24, 1923 to Leo Thomas and Marie Grace (Coady) Flattery in Georgetown, Iowa. He was a 1942 graduate of Georgetown High School.

On June 1, 1950 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Albia David and Grace Marie Wilson were united in marriage. David and Grace were blessed with six children and 60 years of marriage.
