Lloyd Dwane Nichols, age 90 of Albia, passed away Thursday, November 7, 2013, at his daughter's home in Albia.

Lloyd was born March 8, 1923 to Don O. and Gertrude Ann (Stogdill) Nichols in Beaconsfield, IA. He married Eunice Marie White March 28, 1942, in Memphis, MO. They shared 68 years of marriage before her passing on January 25, 2011

Lloyd grew up and attended school in Davis City and Lamoni. He served his country in the United States Army during World War II and was stationed in England, Burma, North Africa, and India, where he was a medic and military policeman. Lloyd and Eunice operated a family farm, Loney's Restaurant, and LE Concessions. They also managed the Albia Country Club and later the Chariton Country Club.
