January 14, 1935 - October 24, 2009

Lyle T. Morgan, age 74, of Lovilia, died Saturday, October 24, 2009, at the Methodist Hospital in Des Moines. Lyle was born January 14, 1935, at home in Albia, Iowa, to Thomas J. and Lorena (Hunt) Morgan. He graduated from Albia High School in 1954. He attended Simpson College until he began working at the Maytag Company in Newton, Iowa. He served in the United States Army from 1957 to 1959 in Germany. He returned to work at Maytag and retired at "30 & out" in 1985.

Lyle enjoyed sports, hunting, fishing, trapping, camping and was an avid Hawkeye fan. He especially liked his grandchildren's sporting events. Military veterans were his heroes.

Lyle married Kae Wells of Lovilia on May 23, 1957. They were blessed with three children, one daughter, Julie (Jeff) Trinkle, of Albia and two sons, Tom (Terri) Morgan, of Bussey, and Bill (Teresa) Morgan, of Knoxville. He is survived by his wife, children, 13 grandchildren and three great grandchildren; one sister, Phyllis Conner (Ray Mosbarger); a brother-in-law, Ed Chidester, all of Albia, and many nieces and nephews.

Lyle is preceded in death by his parents, Thomas and Lorena (Hunt) Morgan, two sisters, Marilyn Simmons Lathen and Jean Chidester, and one brother, Larry Morgan; three brother-in-laws, Leland Simmons, Jack Lathen, Don Conner, and one sister-in-law, Debbie Morgan.

Celebration of life services will be held at 10:30 A.M., on Tuesday, October 27, 2009, at the Winfield Funeral Home in Albia, followed by military rites provided

by the Howard Cessna Post #137 of Albia. Pastor Vince Goemaat will officiate. Cremation will follow at a later date. Visitation will begin at 2:00 P.M., on Monday, October 26, 2009, with the family present from 6:00 to 8:00 P.M. A memorial has been established for the Lovilia Fire Department.
