December 20, 1906 - June 15, 2008

Mary Alice (Stone) Crall, age, 101, of Albia, died Sunday June 15, 2008, at the Monroe County Hospital (Hospice Room) in Albia, Iowa.

Mary was born December 20, 1906 in Marceline, Missouri to George L. and Johanna M. (Feehan) Stone. She married John Joseph Crall on December 31, 1929 at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Georgetown, Iowa. Mary and John were members of St. Patrick's Catholic Church for over fifty years and they celebrated their golden anniversary in 1979. John died October 15, 1983.

Mary was a homemaker and after moving to Albia she transferred her membership to St. Mary's Catholic Church in Albia and its Altar and Rosary Society. Mary loved to cook and she enjoyed playing cards with family and friends.
