Mary Aileen Pabst, 97 of Albia, Iowa died at the Monroe County Hospital, early Tuesday morning, April 15, 2008. Aileen was born in Albia, Iowa June 7, 1910 to Dr. George Allen and Zora Belle Cramer Jenkins. She graduated from Albia High School, Stephens College, Columbia, Missouri, and Drake University where she received a bachelor degree in secondary education. She was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority.

Visitation for Mrs. Pabst will be held Friday, April 18, 2008, at the Winfield Funeral Home from 4 to 8:00 P.M., with Aileen's family present throughout the evening.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 A.M., Saturday, April 19, 2008, at the First Christian Church in Albia. Burial will follow services at Oak View Cemetery in Albia.
