Mary Smith, age 88 of Gillette, WY, formerly of Albia, died Saturday, January 5, 2013 at her daughter's home in Wyoming.

Mary was born July 2, 1924 to John and Teresa (Cappellin) Simonetto in Albia. She married Hubert L. Smith on November 24, 1942 in Fort Leonard Wood, MO. After 58 years of marriage, he preceded her in death on March 13, 2001.
