Rino J. Della Vedova, age 91, of Albia, died Thursday, January 29, 2009, at Monroe Care Center, in Albia.

Rino was born on March 29, 1917, in Albia, Iowa to Virgil Jack and Mary (Paveglio) Della Vedova. He went to school and graduated from Albia High School. After High School, Rino attended Albia Junior College and Chicago Tech for Engineering.

After College Rino married Ruth A. Campbell on August 9, 1941 in Unionville, MO. Rino and Ruth were married for 54 years before Ruth died on February 18, 1996.

Rino entered the United States Army and served in World War II as a Major. After Rino returned from the service he owned and operated Della Vedova Construction with his brother Aldo from 1945 until their retirement.

Rino was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic Church of Albia, Albia Rotary Club, the Albia Masonic Astro Lodge, 3rd degree Knight of Columbus, council #4167. Rino was also a member of the American Legion, Howard Cessna Post #136 of Albia,

Rino is survived by his son, Dennis Della Vedova and his wife Virginia of Albia; two grandchildren; several great grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

Rino is preceded in death by his parents Jack and Mary; one brother, Aldo Della Vedova; and one sister, Mary Fluegge.
