



## Robert Cecil Murphy

Robert Cecil "Bob" Murphy, age, 85, of Albia, died Friday afternoon, February 14, 2008, at the Monroe Care Center in Albia, Iowa.

Robert was born October 23, 1922 in Albia, Iowa to James and Gladys (Byerley) Murphy. Robert was raised in Albia and attended Albia High School.
