



## Stephen Francis Kosman

February 3, 1963 - September 26, 2025

Stephen “Steve” Francis Kosman, age 62, of Albia, IA, passed away on Friday, September 26, 2025, at the University of Iowa Hospital in Iowa City, IA.

Steve was born on February 3, 1963, at the hospital in Centerville, IA, to Francis Joseph and Helen Margaret (Johnson) Kosman. He grew up attending school and graduated from Albia High School with the Class of 1981. He then went to Indian Hills Community College where he studied Diesel Mechanics. In 1992, Steve began dating the love of his life, Debbie Cochran. They shared 33 years together prior to his passing.

Steve had a lifelong career as a skilled mechanic. While in high school, he worked for Castings Standard gas station and later at the Lovilia Trading Post. He then went to work for Foodliner as a mechanic before going to work at Duea Motor Company. He most recently worked as a mechanic for the Monroe County Secondary Roads Dept. before retiring.
