



## Steven Joseph Delaney

April 12, 1957 - February 24, 2011

Steven Joseph Delaney, age 53, longtime cattleman near Melrose, IA died at home Thursday, February 24, 2011 following a tenacious battle with cancer. Steve was born April 12, 1957 to Terry and Mary Delaney of Lake Park, IA. Steve grew up farming and after graduating from Iowa State University in 1979 settled on Delaney Ranch near Melrose, IA raising primarily cattle and hay until death.

He was a devout catholic serving on St. Patrick's Georgetown Church Parish and Finance Councils for several years. Steve loved children and was very talented with cattle, machinery, and people. He frequently helped a neighbor, friend or family member in need whether asked to or not. To truly know Steve was to love him and to love him was a privilege.

He is survived by his wife, Barb; his children and stepchildren Josh, Pete, Jennifer, Laura, Samantha, Charlie, Alex, Eric, and Bret; and two grandchildren. He is also survived by his mother, Mary of Milford, IA; siblings, John (Patty) and Paul (Tammy) of Lake Park, IA, Jim of Albia, IA and Ann of Mt. Pleasant, IA; also sister-in-law, Mary Beth of Ottumwa; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father, Terry; and a brother, Mike.
