Stephen Nicolas Tibbals, age 22 of Centerville, passed away Sunday, August 18, 2013, due to injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

Stephen was born October 28, 1990, to Sherri Tibbals in Ottumwa.

A graduate of Albia High School, class of 2009, Stephen went on to attend Indian Hills Community College. He worked construction, farmed, and worked for Iowa Steel and Wire.

Stephen loved being outdoors fishing and hunting. In high school he wrestled, played baseball, football, and basketball. He also enjoyed playing the guitar and video games. However, nothing was more important to Stephen than his children.

Stephen is survived by two children, Lilly Isabella Tibbals and Jaxen Allen-Grant Tibbals; his parents, Sherri and Randy Kellar of Albia; a brother, Randy Jr. of Albia; grandparents, Don and Sharon Tibbals of Albia; and several step brothers, step sisters, aunts, uncles, and cousins.
