Verl Morgan, age 80 of Albia, Iowa, passed away early Tuesday morning, November 24, 2009, at Monroe County Hospital in Albia.

Verl was born on October 3, 1929, to Harry and Alice (Repp) Morgan in Albia, Iowa. He attended school at Buffalo Waller, a one room school in Monroe County. Verl married Edna Osteen on August 20, 1950, in Floris, Iowa. Edna passed away after forty-nine years of marriage in February 1999.

Verl worked at Maytag on the assembly line for thirty years retiring in December 1978. He was a past member of the Eagles Club in Albia. Verl was a member of The River of Life Church in Albia. He enjoyed watching the Indianapolis Colts, being outdoors, fishing, gardening, his fruit trees, hunting mushrooms, and arrowheads. He was also very talented when it came to musical instruments. Verl could play anything from the harmonica to the organ and he loved to spend time with family and friends
