



Walter Thomas Belzer

Walter "Bus" Thomas Belzer, age 76, of Albia died Tuesday, February 7, 2006 at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa. He was born July 18, 1929 in Eddyville, Iowa to Adrian and Alice (Adair) Belzer. He married Mildred Scott on September 8, 1946 at Mildred's parents home in rural Eddyville.
